EXIM Thailand Launches CSR Project to Support Field Hospitals for COVID-19 Patients

Therefore, EXIM Thailand has donated a number of these necessities worth 200,000 baht in total to the BMA and Thammasat University Hospital to support their field hospitals in accommodating and treating COVID-19 patients, comprising electric fans, PPE sets, N95 and medical face masks, hot & cold water dispensers and drinking water under the Bank's corporate social responsibility (CSR) project titled "EXIM for Community Health."

"This support for the operations of field hospitals is in line with EXIM Thailand's objective to participate in enhancement of the preparedness of our true Superheroes, namely medical and public health personnel, who have all along performed their duties with dedication and commitment in order to help the patients recover and return to their normal life, and support all sectors in getting through this crisis just like other crises in the past," added Dr. Rak.
